All direct expenditures <u>subject to New Mexico taxation</u> can qualify!



- Expenditures that are not subject to New Mexico tax

- Nonresident ATL (with the exception of actors)



Regional: Proof of more than one media buy is required.

National: Proof of national media buy is required.


Internet: Proof of an Internet media buy ("ad space") is required.

Local commercials: You qualify for a sales tax-exemption!


Commercials require a signed letter from the Ad Agency or Client describing the relationship with the Production Company and confirming which entity is claiming the credit.

NONRESIDENT BTL CREW PROGRAM

Nonresident BTL crew qualify for a flat 15% Tax Credit on <u>not more than</u> 15% of the production's total New Mexico budget for BTL crew wages.

Number of nonresident BTL positions allowed-

FINAL NM BUDGET: LESS THAN \$2,750,000



FINAL NM BUDGET: BETWEEN \$2,750,000 - \$7,500,00



FINAL NM BUDGET: BETWEEN \$7,500,00 - \$11,000,000



One additional position for every \$10M over \$11M of the final NM budget:

FINAL NM BUDGET: BETWEEN \$11,000,00 - \$21,000,000



FINAL NM BUDGET: BETWEEN \$21,000,00 - \$31,000,000



FINAL NM BUDGET: BETWEEN \$31,000,00 - \$41,000,000



FINAL NM BUDGET: BETWEEN \$41,000,00 - \$51,000,000



FINAL NM BUDGET: BETWEEN \$51,000,00 - \$61,000,000
